

गोव्यातील लोकांनी स्थापन केलेली संस्था म्हणजे 'आमी गोंयकार'. सदर संस्थेचे उदघाटन माननीय मुख्यमंत्री श्री. मनोहरभाई पर्रीकर यांच्या हस्ते १२ ऑक्टोबर २००३ रोजी झाले.संस्थेचे पहिले अध्यक्ष श्री. बाळ देसाई यांच्या समवेत चार्टर्ड अकाउंटंट, डॉक्टर्स, वकील, बॅकर्स, इंजिनियर्स, सामाजिक कार्यकर्ते, शिक्षणतज्ज्ञ, कवी, लेखक, साहित्यिक आणि अनेक कलाकार मंडळी एकत्र आली. चर्चा, बैठका झाल्या, संस्थेच्या उपक्रमाचा आराखडा तयार झाला आणि सभासद नोंदणी सुरू झाली. २००४ मध्ये गोमंत विश्व संमेलनात सहभाग घेऊन आपल्या उपक्रमांना सुरुवात केली म्हणायला हरकत नाही. त्यानंतर अनेक तज्ज्ञ डॉक्टरांनी वैद्यकीय शिबिरं घेतली. उपक्रमाचा एक भाग म्हणून संस्थेने २००७ साली बांदोडा गोवा येथील 'स्नेह मंदिर वृद्धाश्रमाला' १ लाख रूपयांची देणगी अर्पण केली. संस्थेने वधुवर सूचक मंडळाची स्थापना केली. त्यानंतर ज्येष्ठ गायिका ज्योत्स्ना भोळे यांच्या जीवनावर आधारित ज्योत्स्ना नावाचे गाणे हा संगीतमय कार्यक्रम, तसेच भांगराळे गोंय हा विविधरंगी कोंकणी कार्यक्रम. गोव्याचे माजी मुख्यमंत्री श्री. मनोहरभाई पर्रीकर यांची दादर येथील सावरकर स्मारक मध्ये गोवा राजकारणाचा बदलता चेहरा या संदर्भात झालेली मुलाखत, कविवर्य बा. भ. बोरकर जन्मशताब्दी निमित्त विविध कार्यक्रम, गोवा स्वातंत्र्यदिन सोहळा तसेच ज्येष्ठ गायक पं. रामदास कामत यांच्या स्मृतीला अभिवादन म्हणून रघुनाथ फडके आणि मिलिंद रायकर यांच्या गायन वादनाचे सादरीकरण. संस्थेच्या आणि काही महत्वपूर्ण उपक्रमाबद्दल सांगितले नाही तर ते अपुरे वाटेल. ते म्हणजे २६/७ मध्ये मुंबईत आलेल्या महाप्रलयात नुकसान झालेल्या ८ कुटुंबियांना आर्थिक मदत करून त्यांचे संसार पुन्हा उभे करण्याचे पुण्य काम संस्थेने केले, तसेच गोव्यातील गरजू विद्यार्थ्यांना शैक्षणिक कर्ज देण्याची योजना त्यांनी आखली. गोव्याहन मुंबईत उपचारासाठी येणाऱ्या राग्णांना तज्ज्ञ डॉक्टरांचं मार्गदर्शन मिळवण्यासाठी एका समितीची स्थापना व उपचारांची व्यवस्था

गेली अनेक वर्षे रसिकमान्य आणि उदंड प्रतिसाद मिळत असलेला या संस्थेचा गोवा फेस्टिवल मुंबई तसेच उपनगरातील रसिकांना एक पर्वणीच असते असे म्हणायला हरकत नाही. या महोत्सवात अनेक सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रम, विविध स्पर्धा, मान्यवरांचे सत्कार, विविध प्रकारचे गोव्यातील स्टॉल्स, गोव्याची परंपरा दाखवणारे

Shaping Lives And Communities



Goa is undergoing transformation which has brought diversity in sources of income. Fortunately, traditional business have survived for centuries and are still the bread winners for many families. Though the state is seeing a lot of modern changes there are a few people who are still involved in local traditional businesses. Goa is unique in everything whether its hospitality or business. Industry in Goa is taking different shape with development in infrastructure and business, but there are areas where traditional Goan businesses and artisans still exist.

"PODER" The traditional bread makers of Goa. The art of bread making is a legacy which is granted by the Portuguese to Goa. These businesses are usually passed down from generation to generation. Hence keeping the secret family recipes alive! The Goan Pao is a culinary masterpiece. Pao is Portuguese word for bread, and the Goan bread-maker is known locally as PODER, an adaptation of the Portuguese Padeiro.

The Goan baker or rightly known to the Goans as 'Poder' is someone who is awaited every day for his delicious and steaming hot bread. They come daily in the mornings, afternoons and the evenings with bread on their bicycles, honking their horns. The children run to get their 'Paos'; having it fresh and hot is the best way to savour it!

In Goa when you ask the Poder to give you bread, he will ask, which one? Because Poders have a variety of

bread to offer. The five main varieties of Goan bread are the soft and chewy Pao, the crisp Undo, the Poie (whole wheat pockets), Kankna (the bangles) and scissored bread or Katriancho Pao.

This business is vital for Goans in the state as it is an important part of their daily life. But sadly, in the recent years the occupation is on a decline. Dropping demand for the traditional Pao, rising prices, few government incentives is making it hard for the Poders to get by. The Poders need practical support for their profession. The Poders need to be supported in their profession and they also need to be assisted economically, socially and family health welfare package. We cannot let modernization ruin a tradition that has been a part of Goa for centuries.

After all we can't forget, Poder has given us all those cherished childhood memories of eating the Pao (bread) with family.




Obituary

SANJAY HEGDE SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRES

Skilling and up skilling is a national need for giving momentum to nation's all round development and progress of the society. From time immemorial, is tradition of worshiping skills, crafts, tools, skilled artisans like carpenters, potters, metal workers, sanitation workers, horticulture workers, weavers to name a few on auspicious days like Dussehra, Akshya Tritiya and Vishvakarma day.

We must preserve these tradition and enrich them in coming centuries.

Formal school, college education is necessary, to get employment but on the job training is essential as it gives experiential learning of what and how to do. Skills guides us in operational implementation as it is guiding principle of Skill India Mission. In a way, skilling and up skilling is a gift one can give to self as it ensures continued earning and satisfaction of being contributor to the progress of our beloved nation. It is therefore essential learning should be continuous all through our life as only a skilled person will grow in today's world. Hon. Prime Minister repeatedly says that India providing smart and skilled man-power solutions to the world should be at the core of our strategy of skilling our youth.

It is therefore, essential to pay attention to gaps in skills to create bridge by continuously Skill, re-skill and up-skill programs using technology. This needs to be expedited as there is going to be a huge demand for re-skilling due to fast changing technology.

Sanjay Hegde, who was also founder and director of Seva Sahayog Foundation, encouraged his team to make a modest attempt in this direction and over past two years, beneficiaries have seen positive impact with increase in earnings and better life style.

In 2017, Sanjay started his dream project of 'skill development centre' in the rural area of Boisar (in Palghar district) for developing hidden talents of rural, underprivileged youth. He used to speak passionately about minimising migration to cities and always wanted to promote reverse migration by providing favourable infrastructure in the villages. This centre was named after him in 2021. Today 'Sanjay Hegde skill development centre' at Boisar runs Beautician courses, masala making, baking, tailoring courses for women and automobile repairing, mobile repairing, computer courses including Microsoft certification for men! Second similar centre was started in his memory at Nerul, Navi Mumbai in 2022. It focuses mainly on computer education.

Till date, young men and women have acquired training at these centres and have taken their first step towards being self-reliant. We do evaluation of these programs on a continuous basis and do course corrections wherever required. Further, many beneficiaries have started their start-up or laghu udyog, Significantly, girl beneficiaries have started earning from professions like beauty parlour, tailoring, cake making, dry snacks production. At these centres, foundation conducts training of poultry farming and goats rearing for women and farmers, who have benefited from it. In coming years we will ensure that this basket of skill courses will grow and more and more beneficiaries will take advantage of these facilities to enrich their livelihood and take our beloved nation to heights of glory which it enjoyed all along.
